## **Twin Lakes Area:**

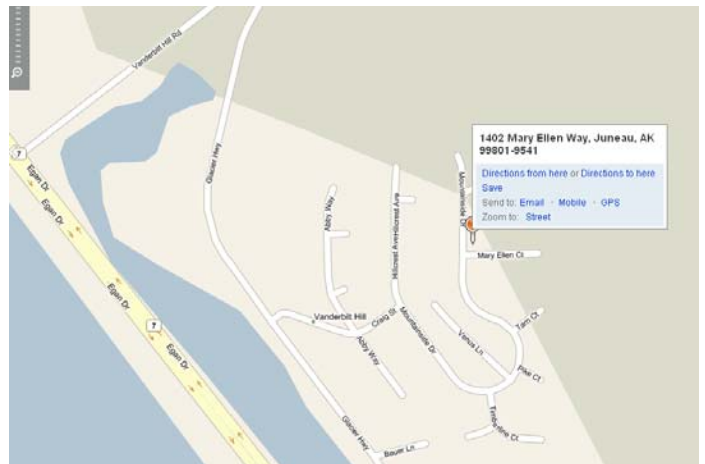
### **1402 Mary Ellen Way** Vanderbilt Hills (Cindy & David Quisenberry)

Beautiful manicured lawn and border perennials surrounding their home. Turn up the hill on Craig St. (at the bus stop on Old Glacier Hwy, near the church.), turn right at Mountainside Dr., follow it up and around to Mary Ellen Way, on the right.

### **1414 Mary Ellen Way** (Karen Hansen)

### **1418 Mary Ellen Way** (Lana Tolls)

Customized natural creek and massive step beds, lively with a variety of trees, shrubs and perennials. Located at the end of the cul-de-sac on Mary Ellen Way. Follow directions listed above.



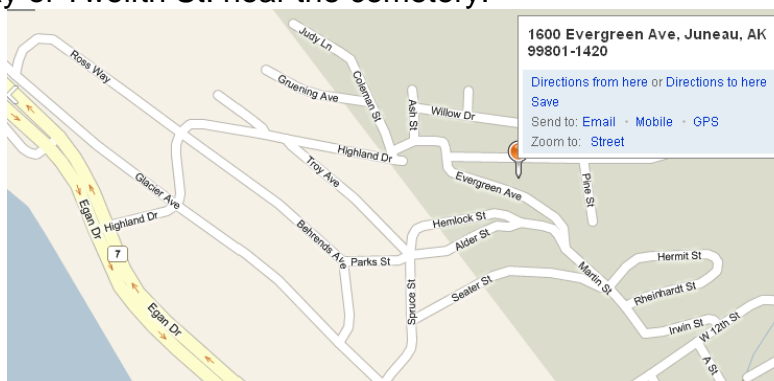
## **Town:**

### **1600 Evergreen Ave** – above JD High School (Ester and Mark Millea)

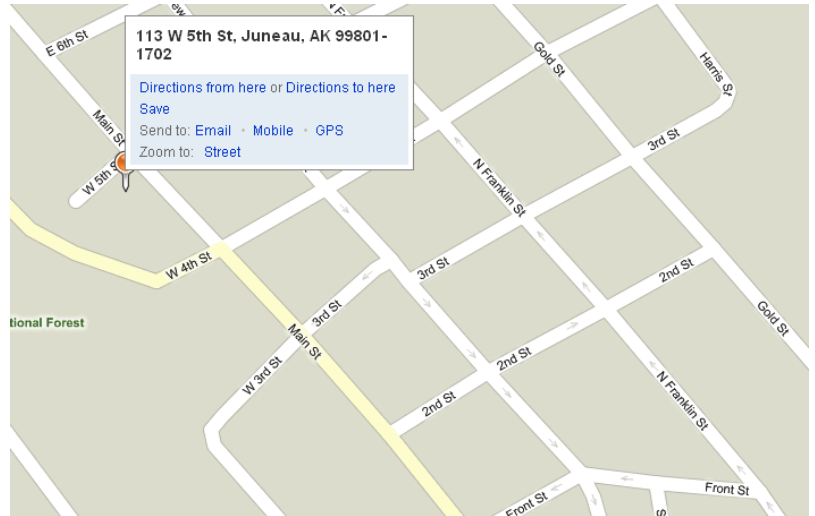
Careful footing required for this unique and established hide-a-way garden in the woods!

Two ways to access:

1. Park at the top of Highland Drive, take path between house and trees to main path
2. Park on Angus St. around corner from upper Evergreen Ave. Entrance is hiding at their brown and coral color trimmed garage just before the corner house, across from upper Evergreen, accessed by way of Twelfth St. near the cemetery.



**113 W. 5<sup>th</sup> St.** – (Marke & Linda Windeborn of Capitol Inn Bed and Breakfast)  
 Downstairs wooden paradise! Oldest Daphne in Juneau? Up Main Street, across from Capitol Bldg., short left, dead end.

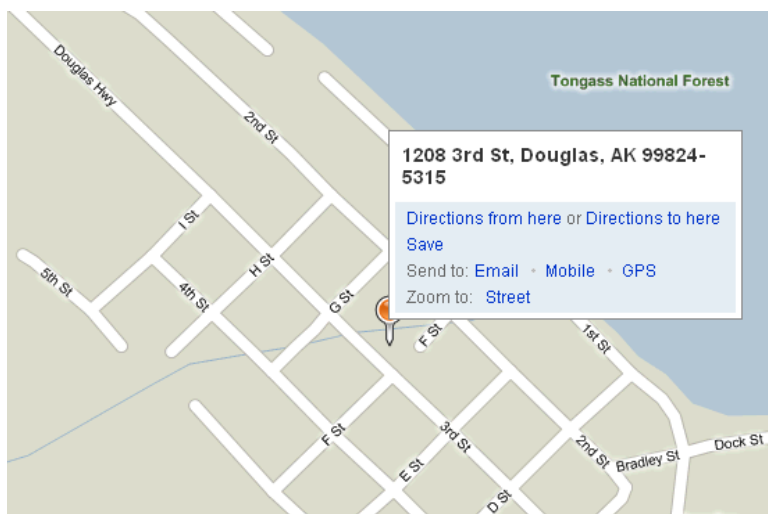
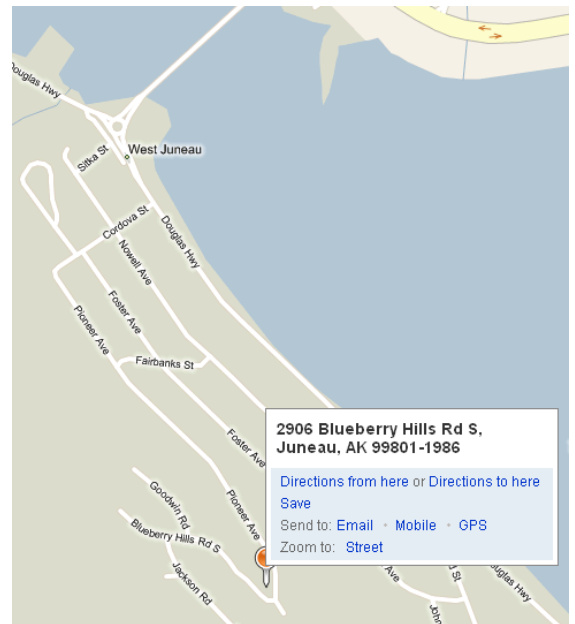


**Douglas:**

 Located on Main Street in Douglas.

Beloved variety of mature mixed with new, pots, beds and paths.

Left at the roundabout on Douglas Island, straight, past Gastineau school, nearby on the left, metal railing at sidewalk.

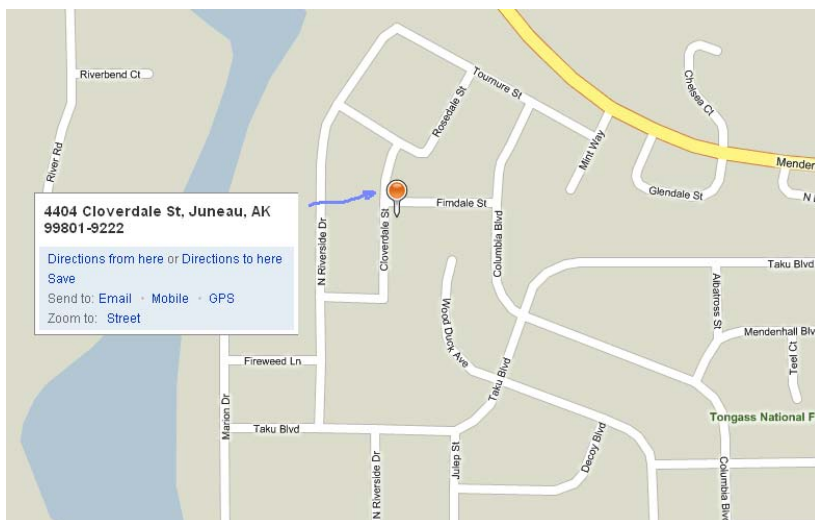
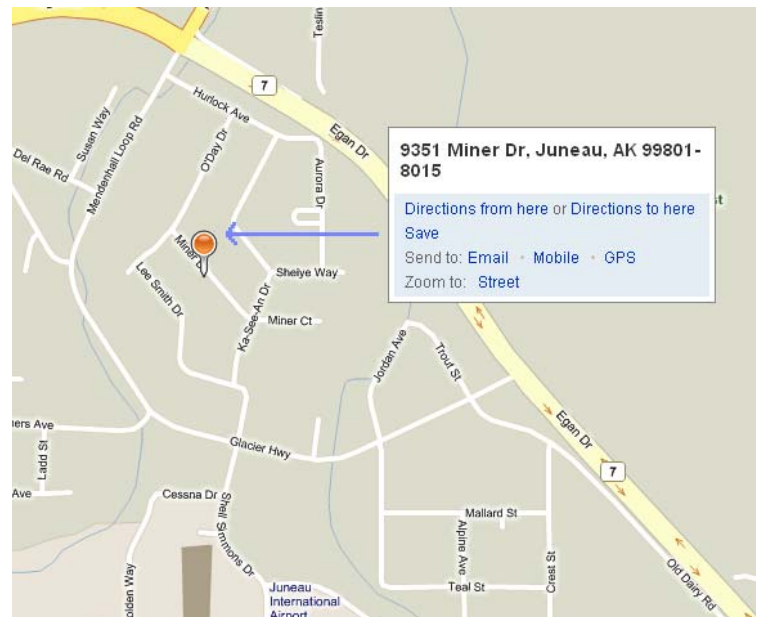

## Valley:

**9351 Minor Court** Between Airport & SuperBear intersection  
(Mary Jefferson)

It rocks in front and sways in back! Turn on Hurlock off of Mendenhall Loop Road at Wells Fargo. Quick right onto Ka-See-An, next court on the left past Sheiye Way.



## **4404 Cloverdale Street**

(Suzanne Forsling)

Gutters can hold more than water!

From Riverside Dr. turn onto Pinedale.

Changes to Cloverdale at the corner.  
Light green house.

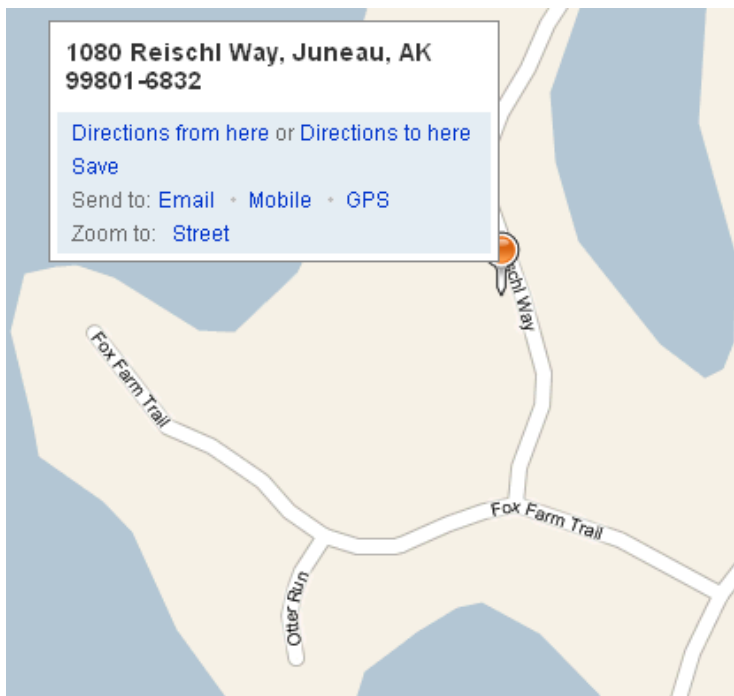
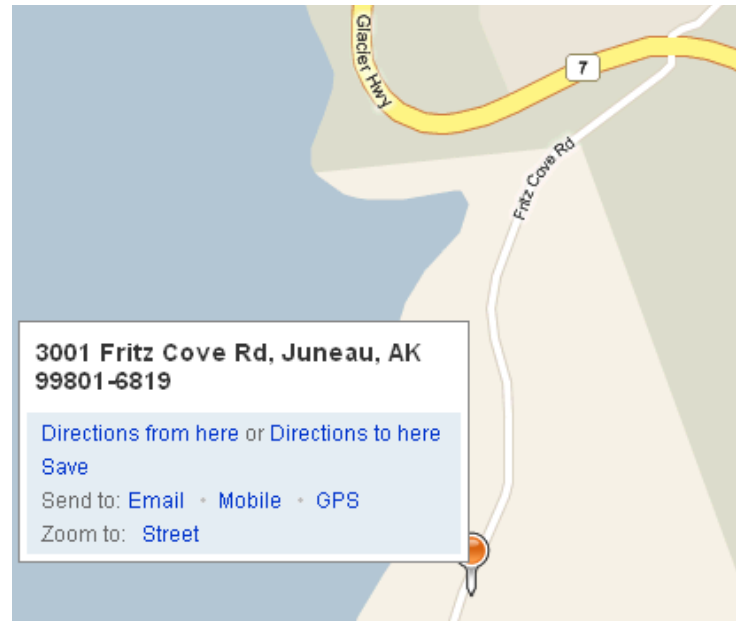
## Fritz Cove:

**3001 Fritz Cove Road** (Becky Carls)  
Primrose heaven tucked in the woods!

Medium sloped driveway and stairs to top garden.

6/10 mile from highway on uphill side. Green house.

Two driveways, take the 2<sup>nd</sup> at green mailbox.



**1080 Reischl Way** (Sherri and John Williams)  
Now the wildlife have fresh water where there was none before!

Take Fritz Cove Road to near the end, right on Fox Farm Trail, first left on Otter run, the left on Reischl Way.

Big rock with house number on it.

## Lena Point:

### **17025 Towers Road** (Rachel and Peter Jurasz)

A little bit of everything you could want! End of the road behind NOAA. Turn onto the first entrance to Lena Loop Road past ball field. Two ways to access:

1. Turn left at the “old” road, follow it around until street on the left. before NOAA Follow it to the end on the left.
2. Stay on the “new” Point Lena Loop Road, follow it around, past Island View Dr. then veer to the left for Towers Road at NOAA.

### **17031 Island View Drive** (Jacqueline Fowler & Detles Buettner)

Watch the fish while the garden grows! Two ways to access:

1. Go to the right out of Towers Rd. onto the “new” Lena Loop Road. and then first road going up the hill on the left.
2. Take the first entrance to Lena off highway, stay on new road till Island View Dr. on the right. Near the end of this cul-de-sac.
